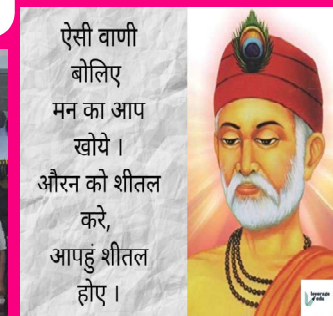
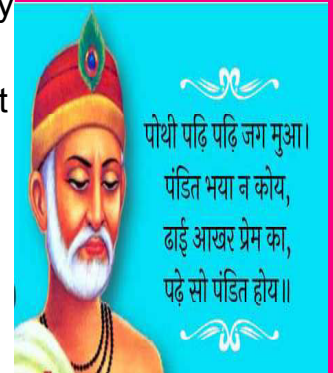
Wall Paintings by Hindi Department Students
