

Feedback For the academic session: 2019-2020

1. Feedback on College Environment by Students:

Responses on Feedback on college environment were collected on Offline mode. Total numbers of respondent participated in this survey are 411. Students from 6th semester Class of various departments took part in this survey.

a. Methods of analysis:

The feedback from the students was taken through questionnaire method and the students were asked to respond to the sets of questions as provided by the concerned cell. For proper analysis of the student's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondent favouring for "Very Good" and "Good" remark.

b. Results:

The details of analysis are given in table-4 showing the responses in percentage against various quality remarks of the questions. Satisfactory responses were provided by the respondents against the majority of the questions, except question number 8 and 11.

b. Issues Identified:

In pursuance of the benchmark set by the feedback cell against each question to be considered as satisfactory response, it was observed that the following questions regarding college environment need proper attention from the college authority:

1. Parking place for students and
2. Power supply condition.

c. Action taken by the authority:

Based on the feedback responses of the students college authority initiated prompt action to address the issues faced by the students. It may be noted that the problem of drinking water facility indicated in the feedback report of 2018-2019 has been fulfilled amicably by the authority, although enough work still needs to be done towards addressing the other persistent issues.

2. Feedback on Teachers' Evaluation by Students:

Assessment of the students' satisfaction on different important parameters of the teacher was done on offline mode.

a. Methods of analysis:

The feedback from the students was taken through questionnaire method and the students were asked to respond to the sets of questions as provided by the concerned cell. For proper analysis of the student's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondents favour for "Excellent" and "Very Good" remark. The Teacher receiving response **below the Benchmark** has been identified as "Under satisfied" for that particular question of the feedback form. The concerned Teacher needs to pay attention to those areas and to initiate remedial measure for the greater interest of the students.

b. Analysis and action taken report:

The details of analysis on Teachers' Evaluation by Students was done department wise and corrective measures towards any shortcomings of the individual teachers was taken

up at the personal level based on the response of the students. Table-5 represents the summary of feedback analysis and action taken report of the teachers of the department on Feedback on Teachers' Evaluation by Students for the Year 2019-2020.

3. Feedback from Parents:

The feedback from parents was taken in offline mode. Total 76 Parents participated in the parents’ satisfaction survey. The questions were framed to know the level of satisfaction of the parents on various aspects of college environment influencing their wards.

a. Methods of analysis:

The feedback from the parents was taken through questionnaire method and they were asked to respond to the sets of questions as provided by the concerned cell. For proper analysis of the parent's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondents favoring for “Strongly Agree” and “Agree” remark.

b. Results:

The analysis of the feedback of the respondent reveals that the parents have indicated positive and satisfactory response against the question number 1 to 7 and 10 of the feedback form. However, the response of the parents were found under satisfied against the question

number 8 & 9. The feedback analysis show slide improvement over the last year response of the parents. The details of analysis are given in table-6.

3. Feedback from Alumni:

The feedback from alumni of the college was taken on offline mode as per our convenience on different occasions and particularly during alumni meet. In the present survey altogether 222 alumni participated in providing their valuable inputs. The questions were mostly on overall progress of the college, suggestions regarding introduction of PG courses etc. Table -7 outlines the summary of the output of the analysis of the alumni feedback.
